Penal Code, 2009

Article 56

3 -Within the established framework of international law, other serious violations of the law of international armed conflicts also constitute war crimes, namely, any of the following acts:

iv. Intentionally directing attacks against buildings dedicated to religion, education, art, science or charitable purposes, historic monuments, hospitals and places where the sick and wounded are collected, provided they are not military objectives.
